## RULES OF THE MEETING

We, the Great Salt Lake Bowling Association Board of Directors present for your approval, the following rules to govern this 2023 annual meeting.

1. Roberts Rules of Order Revised shall govern the procedures of this meeting. Provided they do not conflict with the bylaws of the GSLBA and the USBC.
2. To be recognized, a member must address the Chair by Saying "Madam President" or "Madam/Mister Chairperson". ***Member shall state clearly their name in full.***
3. All motions submitted at the annual meeting shall be stated in the affirmative.
4. A member shall be permitted to speak ***only TWICE*** on any questions limiting each discussion to ***TWO*** minutes. Discussion shall be confined strictly to the motion on the floor and all questions and answers shall be directed to the Chair.
5. In order to expedite the business of the 2023 annual meeting, the members shall give courteous and full attention to the speaker having the floor.
6. Members desiring to leave the meeting must request permission of the Chair.
7. Exceptions to these rules may be made at the discretion of the presiding officer.
8. Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised, 10th Edition (p. 279) applies here, as the USBC bylaws do not address election protests. Objection to the election and reconsideration should be made during the meeting. By remaining silent at the meeting, a member is consenting to the actions taken at the meeting.
9. Any and all protests must be voiced during the meeting at the time of the infraction, i.e., during the election process. If a protest is voiced during the meeting and no action is taken by the presiding officer/ board, then a protest may be filed, in writing, to USBC Headquarters within 15 days of the meeting. Directions on protests during the meeting are announced at the meeting. An appropriate venue would be in the opening remarks or the Rules of the Meeting and/or again by the Chair prior to the elections.

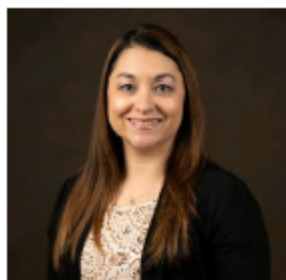
